Previously on List 2.2 as *E. ochrocephalum* var. *alexanderae*; see this name in *TJM* (1993). Known in CA from only

between Potato Pk. and Bodie Mtn., where not seen since 1967; field surveys needed. Potentially threatened by gold mining. Not in *TJM* 2 and treated as a synonym of *E. crosbyae* in *FNA* Vol. 5, which does not occur in CA. See *Great Basin Naturalist* 45:276 (1985) for original description, and *Phytologia* 66(4):295-321 (1989) and 24:33-38 (2011) for taxonomic treatments.
