Federally listed as Endangered on 1977-09-12, then listed as Threatened on 2013-08-26; Delisted due to Recovery on 2023-02-24. Significantly recovering after removal of feral herbivores on SCM Isl. by the Navy. Potentially threatened by Navy activities, frequent fire and fire control measures, erosion, and non-native plants. See *Bulletin of the Southern California Academy of Sciences* 42:31 (1943) for original description.
