Thought extinct for 77 years; only known extant occurrence was rediscovered in 1980 at Pt. Reyes NS. Experimental introduction work ongoing as of 2000. Closely related to *C. pungens*. See *Proceedings of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences* 12:271 (1877) for original description, *Phytologia* 66(2):132-134 (1989) for taxonomic treatment, *Fremontia* 18(1):17-18 (1990) for species account, and *Madroño* 39(4):271-280 (1992) and 40(4):285-288 (1993) for discussion of grazing effects.
