Plants treated as ssp. *eurekense* (known only from the Humboldt Bay area; threatened by development, vehicles, and non-native plants), *menziesii* (nearly extirpated on the Monterey Peninsula; seriously threatened by development, vehicles, deer browsing, and non-native plants), and *yadonii* (known only from near Marina on Monterey Bay; threatened by development and sand mining) are not validly published; see these names in *TJM* (1993).
