# Rare Plant Status Review: Arabis pendulina var. pendulina

Though this taxon occurs in other western states, it is known in California from only a single collection. A specimen was collected by Duran in 1926 from Cottonwood Creek in the White Mountains. This specimen was identified by Rollins.
