

Rare Plant Status Review: *Arabis pendulina* var. *pendulina*

Arabis pendulina var. *pendulina* was reported to occur in California following the publication of the *The Jepson Manual*. Though this taxon occurs in other western states, it is known in California from only a single collection. A specimen was collected by Duran in 1926 from Cottonwood Creek in the White Mountains. This specimen was identified by Rollins.
