Background

Proposed CBR that was postponed from 6th ed. Only a single page in folder. No indication who recommended or why. It's local along the central/south coast range, but doesn't appear to be uncommon or threatened at this time. There are a considerable amount of observations and herbarium vouchers of this plant; 248 CCH records, approximately 75 non-duplicates, and 11 observations in Calflora. If someone were to bring this up as a possible addition in the future due to declines or threats, we may want to look into it at that time, but there is currently no compelling reason to review it; ostensibly too common.
