Herbarium material is difficult to identify; needs field surveys. Similar to *S. asprella*, *S. gigantea*, and *S. robusta*. A synonym of *S. malviflora* ssp. *asprella* in *TJM* (1993). See *Flora of California* 2(1):492-493 (1936) by W.L. Jepson for original description and *Madroño* 56(2):285-292 (2009) for taxonomic treatment.
