Notes

Not clearly distinguishable from var. *luteolum* north of Tiburon. *E. luteolum* is similar to *E. gracile* to the south and *E. vimineum* to the northeast. Threatened by development, foot traffic, and non-native plants. See *Flora Franciscana*, pp. 150-151 (1891) by E. Greene for original description, and *Phytologia* 66(4):378-379 (1989) for alternative treatment which restricts var. *caninum* to ALA and MRN counties.
