Background

Proposed for addition on 2/23/2017 due to reported less than 50 occurrences in CA. Sources say otherwise. 195 specimens in CCH, estimated 80 non-dups in Jepson eFlora. Jepson eFlora includes GV and south coast, but yellow flags are popping up in PR, WTR, SCoRO, n SNH, NCoRO, and MP. Furthermore, eFlora notes "disturbed soils" and "evidently spreading to reservoirs near enough to be considered ScV." Demonstrably common and widespread, arguably has weedy tendencies.
