Rare Plant Status Review: *Malacothrix similis* Kristi Lazar and Roxanne Bittman (CNDDB) January 17, 2007

Background

Malacothrix similis is an annual herb in the Asteraceae. This species is known in California from 3 localities; one collection from Santa Cruz Island in 1888, one from San Miguel Island in 1886, and a collection from Hueneme Beach in Ventura County in 1925. While M. similis has not been collected or observed in California for more than 80 years, it is fairly common in Baja California. In The Jepson Manual (1993), M. similis was treated under M. stebbinsii with the note that *M. similis* is "mostly of Mexico, collected twice in California". However, further study into Malacothrix shows that it does appear to be a distinct species and the author for the Malacothrix treatment for the new edition of The Jepson Manual (who is the same author as the Malacothrix treatment for the 1993 Jepson Manual) plans to recognize *M. similis* as a species extinct in California. *M. similis* is very similar to *M. clevelandii*; however, it is distinguishable from *M.* clevelandii by differences in leaf morphology, growth habit, and pollen size. It is thought that this species may still be found on one or more of the Channel Islands and may be "masquerading" as M. clevelandii. M. similis occurs on coastal plains, beaches, and dunes from 0 to 40 meters in elevation. The Flora of North America mentions that this species is "of conservation concern".

M. similis is known from 3 occurrences in California that are presumed extinct and requires review for inclusion in both the CNPS inventory and the CNDDB.
